

Changing to the College of Engineering from other Colleges within Qatar University

Students who are interested in transferring to the college of engineering from other colleges within Qatar University must fulfil the following requirements to apply to the College of Engineering. These requirements are a way of assessing their academic abilities and ensuring they will be able to cope with the level of study within the college.

Transfer Requirements:

- Students applying for change of major must adhere to the academic track of their secondary school certificate. In order to be eligible for change of major to College of Engineering, students must have completed their secondary school certificate in a Science or a Technology track respectively. Consequently, students who have completed their secondary school certificate in an Arts track will not be eligible to apply for change of major to College of Engineering. This policy is applicable to all students admitted to Qatar University in Fall 2021 and onwards.

- Students who did not satisfy the admission requirements for the CENG at the time of initial admission to Qatar University may apply to change their academic major after completing a minimum number of 24 credit hours with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5/4.00

- **Mathematics Competency**

SAT Scholastic Aptitude Test SAT (General Math component- <u>New version</u>)	570 or higher
Math Placement Test	235 or higher

Important Notes:

- In Special cases and based on the availability within the foundation program, the college may accept some students in the foundation program for passing the English and Mathematics requirements.
- Transferring to the CENG is extremely competitive and is subject to the capacity of the college; satisfying the minimum requirements does not guarantee accepting your request.
- Students transferred from other colleges are accepted in General Engineering or Engineering Foundation. Students must apply later to declare their major through the “Declaring Major” process, taking into consideration the [programs requirements](#).
