




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A Year of Outstanding Achievements and Innovation at QU Health

As we celebrate the academic year 2023-2024, we proudly reflect on QU Health Sector's commitment to excellence in health education, research, and community engagement. This year has been a defining moment for us as we lead the charge in addressing Qatar's health needs, significantly contributing to national development and enhancing the global stature of our programs.

Our vibrant student body has reached an impressive 2,097 students, with 40.88% representing Qatari nationals. We proudly celebrated the graduation of 255 students, with 26.27% being Qatari, exemplifying our dedication to cultivating the next generation of health professionals who will shape the future of health in Qatar.

Our academic programs continue to expand and evolve, highlighted by the successful **full accreditation of our six-year Doctor of Medicine program** and the graduation of our inaugural cohort from the Master's in Health Professions Education. Moreover, our Pharmacy and Medicine programs have reaffirmed their global excellence, achieving rankings of 101-150 and 301-350, respectively, in the QS World University Rankings.

Research remains at the core of our mission, with an impressive 855 publications this year, 76% of which were featured in top-tier journals. Our esteemed faculty and researchers are at the forefront of advancing knowledge in critical areas, including diabetes, mental health, and cancer. We are particularly proud that 31 of our researchers have been recognized in the prestigious Elsevier-Stanford Top 2% list, underscoring our commitment to impactful scientific contributions.

This year, we have secured a remarkable more than 43 million Qatari Riyals in competitive grants, driving innovation and discovery across our research initiatives. Our commitment to health advancements is further demonstrated by the acquisition of **four new patents** focused on pioneering treatments and diagnostics.

In 2023 - 2024, QU Health Sector continued to strengthen its collaborative efforts through strategic partnerships that emphasize clinical research and advanced training. These collaborations are crucial in equipping our students with the practical skills necessary to excel in their careers while propelling research that leads to improved health outcomes.


Legal Responsibility of Medical Practices in Qatari Law




During the 2023-2024 academic year, the QU Health Sector launched a series of impactful events focused on education, awareness, and engagement.






