We are pleased to announce that Ms. Salma Baddou, BSc from Leiden University, Netherlands, has successfully completed her MSc elective internship at Qatar University College of Pharmacy. Her internship was conducted under the supervision of Prof. Mohamed Izham, PhD, Prof. Ahmed Awaisu, PhD, and Clinical Assistant Prof. Rana Al Adawi, RPh, PhD (Clinical Pharmacist at Hamad General Hospital).
